

Kansas Stole and Pochette

One size Difficulty: Very Easy

Materials:

400g Kansas yarn by Effe-Elle Knitting needles 10 mm (UK 000) Scissors Satin ribbon (1,5 m) Darning needle Sewing thread

Stitch explanation:

- Stocking Stitch: Row1:knit(k); Row 2: purl (p)
- Garter Stitch: Knit every row

Size:

Stole: 85 x 48 cm (33,49" x 18,91") Pochette: 21 x 33 cm (8,27" x 13")

Stole

Making:

Cast on 34 sts.

Row 1-6 Work in Stocking Stitch

Row 7 Purl

Row 8-12 Work in Stocking Stitch

Row 13-34 Work in Garter Stitch

Row 35-41 Work in Stocking Stitch

Row 42 Purl

Row 43-47 Work in Stocking Stitch

Cast off

Finishing:

Weave in ends. Cut 1,2 metre of satin ribbon in two. Gather together each one of the shorter side of the rectangle and sew a piece of ribbon on the gatering.

Pochette

Making:

Cast on 18 sts.

Work in garter stitch until the rectangle measures 33 cm (13")

Cast off

Finishing:

Fold the longer side of the rectangle in two. Close the bag by sewing the two lateral sides and the first and last 5 cm of the upper side. Turn the bag and thread the remaining ribbon (30 cm) in the middle of the bag aperture. Tie a bow to close your pochette.
