





# Orange Flambée

### Size:

M/L

## Gauge:

21 sts in stockinette st= cm 10x10, after blocking (4,5 mm knitting needles).

### **Materials:**

**Yarn**: Flambé by Borgo de'Pazzi (100% Cotton - 50 gr +/- 105 m): 350 gr. Circular needles 4.5 mm and 3.5 mm with 40 - 60 - and 80 cm cables. Stitch markers, tapestry needle.

### Stitches&Abbreviations:

Stockinette stitch worked in the round. Fantasy rib stitch.

k = knit

p = purl

y/o = yarn over

ssk= slip, slip, knit: slip one stitch on the right needle as to knit it, slip the next stitch on the right needle as to knit it, place them back to the left needle and knit them together in the back loop.

k2tog = knit 2 together

M = Stitch Marker

PM = Place Stitch Marker

SM = Slip Stitch Marker

RM = Remove Stitch Marker

w&t = wrap & turn





### SPECIAL TECHNIQUES

### w&t = wrap & turn

On the right side of the work: work until the stitch which has to be wrapped and turned. Move the yarn on the front side of the work, slip one stitch on the right needle as to purl it, move again the yarn on the back of the work, slip back the wrapped stitch to the left needle and turn your work. Go on working in the opposite direction. On the wrong side of the work: work until the stitch which has to be wrapped and turned. Move the yarn on the back of the work, slip one stitch on the right needle as to purl it, move again the stitch on the front of the work , slip back the wrapped stitch to the left needle and turn your work. Go on working in the opposite direction. How to work wrapped stitches: On the right side of the work: lift the wrapping yarn from the front side of the work, put it on the left needle, and knit the yarn and the stitch together. On the wrong side of the work: lift the wrapping yarn from the back of the work and put it on the left needle, purl the yarn and the stitch together.

### I-cord edge:

With the working yarn cast on 3 new stitches: move them back on the left needle and knit them. Move them back on the left needle, knit 2 stitches and knit 2 stitches together through the back loops: from now on you start to work this way all the stitches in the round. Move the 3 stitches on the left needle and repeat the pass we just explained, that is: knit 2 stitches, knit 2 stitches together through the back loops.

Keep going knitting this way until all stitches have been worked.

Bind off the stitches joining the just knitted stitches with the ones you casted on.

Cut the yarn and weave in the ends.

### Let's start from the neck line:

Using 4,5mm circular needles with 60 cm cable cast on 156 stitches checking that all stitches show in the same direction. Close the work in the round and place a stitch marker showing the beginning of the round.

Round 1: \*k3, p3\*

Round 2: \*y/o1, ssk, k1, y/o1, p2tog, p1\*

Repeat round 1 and 2 29 times, and round 1 more time (59 rounds).

Round 60: \*ssk, k1, y/o1, p2tog, p1, y/o1, (ssk, k1, p2tog, p1) twice, ssk, k1, y/o1, p2tog, p1, y/o1, (ssk, k1, p2tog, p1) 9 times\*, repeat from\* to\* once again. (112 stitches)

Round 61: work the stitches as they show themselves and knit the yarn overs.

Now we start working short rows until we finish the neck line. We are going to work in rows and no more in the round.

Row 1: k3, y/o1, PM, p2, y/o1, k12, y/o1, PM, p2, y/o1, k40, y/o1, PM, p2, y/o1, k12, y/o1, PM, p2, y/o1, k5, w&t. (88 stitches)

Row 2: work 88 stitches as they show themselves (purl the yarn overs). Once done, p2, w&t. (90 stitches)

Row 3: k6, y/o1, SM, p2, y/o1, k14, y/o1, SM, p2, y/o1, k42, y/o1, SM, p2, y/o1, k14, y/o1, SM, p2, y/o1, k8, w&t. (100 stitches)

Row 4: work 100 stitches as they show themselves (purl the yarn overs). Once done, p2, w&t. (102 stitches)

Row 5: k9, y/o1, SM, p2, y/o1, k16, y/o1, SM, p2, y/o1, k44, y/o1, SM, p2, y/o1, k16, y/o1, SM, p2, y/o1, k11, w&t. (113 stitches)

Row 6: work 113 stitches as they show themselves (purl the yarn overs). Once done, p2, w&t. (115 stitches)

Row 7: k12, y/o1, SM, p2, y/o1, k18, y/o1, PM, p2, y/o1, k46, y/o1, PM, p2, y/o1, k18, y/o1, PM, p2, y/o1, k15, w&t. (125 stitches)

Row 8: work 125 stitches as they show themselves (purl the yarn overs). Once done, p3, w&t. (128 stitches)

Row 9: k16, y/o1, SM, p2, y/o1, k20, y/o1, PM, p2, y/o1, k48, y/o1, PM, p2, y/o1, k20, y/o1, PM, p2, y/o1, k20, w&t. (140 stitches)

Row 10: work stitches as they show themselves (purl the yarn overs). Once done, p4, w&t. (144 stitches)

Row 11: k21, y/o1, SM, p2, y/o1, k22, y/o1, PM, p2, y/o1, k50, y/o1, PM, p2, y/o1, k22, y/o1, PM, k2, y/o1, k21, work the last 8 hold on stitches. Place a titch marker showing the beginning of the round and start again to work in the round. (160 stitches)

Round 12: work all stitches as they show themselves (knit the yarn overs); keep going with raglan increases on every odd round (Round 13-15-17-...) 17°....) 21 more times (54 rounds, 328 stitches).





### Separating the sleeves from the body:

Round 55: Remove the stitch marker showing the beginning of the round, knit until you reach the next stitch marker, RM, k1, put on hold the next 68 stitches (sleeve) removing the second stitch marker, cast on 3 new stitches, PM (new stitch marker showing the beginning of the round, cast on 3 new stitches, knit until you reach the next stitch marker, RM, k1, put on hold the next 68 stitches (sleeve) removing the 4th stitch marker, cast on 6 new stitches, knit until you reach the next stitch marker (new stitch marker showing the beginning of the round). (204 stitches).

# Round 56 to 110: knit.

Now we go on with short rows only on the back side stopping to work in rounds, and working in rows.

Row 1: k57, w&t.

Row 2: p12, w&t.

Row 3: k17, w&t.

Row 4: p22, w&t.

Row 5: k27, w&t.

Row 6: p32, w&t.

Row 7: k37, w&t.

Row 8: p42, w&t.

Row 9: k47, w&t.

Row 10: p52, w&t.

Row 11: k57, w&t.

Row 12: p62, w&t.

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Row 13: k68, w&t.

Row 14: p74, w&t.

Row 15: k80, w&t.

Row 16: p86, w&t.

Row 17: k94, w&t.

Row 18: p102, w&t.







### Let's start again to work in rounds

Round 111: k204.

Change to 3,5 mm tips and work as follows:

Round 112: \*k3, p3\*.

Round 113: \*y/o1, ssk, k1, y/o1, p2tog, p1\*.

Round 114: \*k3, p3\*.

Round 115: RM, slip 1 stitch as to knit, PM, \*y/o1, k1, ssk, y/o1, p1, p2tog\*.

Repeat rounds 112 to 115 4 more times.

Round 132: like round 112

Bind off all stitches during round 133.

### Sleeves:

With 4,5 mm circular needles and 40 cm cable work again 3 stitches of the armpit, the 68 stitches you previously put on hold and the remaining 3 stitches of the armpit. (74 stitches)

Work 6 rounds in stockinette stitch.

Round 7: SM, k1, k2tog, knit until you reach 3 stitches before the M, ssk, k1.

Keep going with stockinette stitch repeating the decreases at rounds 14-21-28-35-42 and 49. (60 stitches)

Change to 3,5 mm tips and work as follows:

Round 51: \*k3, p3\*.

Round 52: \*y/o1, ssk, k1, y/o1, p2tog, p1\*.

Round 53: \*k3, p3\*.

Round 54: RM, slip 1 stitch as to knit, PM, \*y/o1, k1, ssk, y/o1, p1, p2tog\*.

Repeat rounds 51to 54 4 more times.

Round 71: like round 51.

Bind off all stitches during round 72.

### Finishing:

Work the I-cord edge on the 112 stitches at the bottom of the lace neck line.

Weave in the ends.

Wash the pullover in cold water with an appropriate detergent (soap), rinse it and lie it down on a table until it is well dried.
