S2 knitted fair isle snoods for Halloween [

Size: Big snood: 70x30cm Small snood: 50x17cm Yarns: Borgo de' Pazzi 'Luna' 2 balls grey color 2 balls orange color 1 ball black color 1 ball green color Every ball is 50g-80m (1.7oz ~88yds)

Every ball is Sug~80m (1.702 ~88yus)

Needles: 8.00mm mm circular needles (40cm) Tapestry needle, stitche marker

Gauge: 14sts/18 rows in 4x4" 10x10cm)

Abbreviations:

KMC - knit with main color yarns
KMC tbl - knit with main color through
the back loop
KCC1/2 - knit with contrast color yarns
PMC - purl with main color yarns
PMC - purl with contrast color yarns
PM - place stitches marker
SM - stitches marker
St / sts - stitches
*, * - repeat

How to make a Latvian braid :

1rnd. *Purl 1MC, bring CC under MC (twisting yarns), purl 1CC, bring MC under CC (twisting yarns) *repeat until end.
2 rnd. *Purl 1MC, bring CC over MC (twisting yarns), purl 1CC, bring MC over CC (twisting yarns)* repeat until end.



Snood with pumpkins and cats

With 8.00mm needles and main color (grey) yarns Cast on 84 sts, place sts marker and ioin in round. Knit first round Knit the next round as follows: 1rnd. *k1MC tbl, p1MC* repeat until end Repeat 1 rnd x6 times. Continue as follows: 1 rnd. KMC until end 2 rnd. KMC until end 3 rnd. Join black color (CC1), * K1MC, k1CC1* repeat until end; 4 rnd. *k1CC1, k1MC* repeat until end 5-6 rnds. KMC until end 7 rnd. Join orange color (CC2), *k3MC, k7CC1, k6MC, k8CC2, k4MC* repeat until end 8 rnd. *k2MC, k3CC1, k1MC, k6CC1, k3MC, k10CC2, k3MC* repeat until end 9 rnd. Join green yarns (CC3) *k2MC, k2CC1, k2MC, k6CC1, k3MC, k2CC2, k1CC1, k1CC2, k1CC1, k1CC2, k1CC1, k4CC2, k1CC3, k1MC* repeat until end 10 rnd. *k2MC, k2CC1, k2MC, k6CC1, k2MC, k4CC2, k1CC1, k1CC2, k1CC1, k1CC2, k1CC1, k3CC2, k1CC3, k1MC* repeat until end 11 rnd. *k2MC, k2CC1, k2MC, k6CC1, k2MC, k12CC2, k2CC3* repeat until end 12 rnd. *k2MC, k2CC1, k2MC, k6CC1,k2MC, k4CC2, k1CC1, k3CC2, k1CC1, k3CC2, k1CC3, k1MC* repeat until end 13 rnd. *k3MC, k2CC1, k2MC, k4CC1,k3MC, k1CC2, k1CC1, k2CC2, k1CC1, k3CC2, k1CC1, k3CC2, k2MC* repeat until end 14 rnd. *k2MC, k1CC1, k3MC, k6CC1, k2MC, k2CC1, k6CC2, k1CC3, k1CC2, k1CC3, k3MC* repeat until end 15 rnd. *k2MC, k2CC1, k1MC, k8CC1, k3MC, k1CC1, k5CC2, k3CC3, k3MC* repeat until end 16 rnd. *k5MC, k2CC1, k1CC2, k2CC1, k1CC2, k2CC1, k1MC, k2CC1, k1MC, k3CC3, k1CC1, k3CC3, k4MC* repeat until end 17 rnd. *k5MC, k2CC1, k1CC2, k2CC1, k1CC2, k2CC1, k3MC, k3CC3, k2MC, k2CC3, k3MC*

repeat until end
18 rnd. *k5MC, k8CC1, k3MC, k2CC3, k10MC* repeat until end
19 rnd. *k6MC, k6CC1, k16MC* repeatuntil end
20 rnd. *k6MC, k2CC1, k2MC, k2CC1, k16MC* repeat until end
21 rnd. *k6MC, k1CC1, k4MC, k1CC1, k16MC* repeat until end
22 rnd. KMC until end
23 rnd. Repeat round 3
24 rnd. Repeat round 4
25-26 rnd. KMC until end

27 rnd. *k1MC tbl, p1MC* Repeat round 27 x6 times. Bind off.



Snood with spiders

Join black color (CC)


With 8.00mm needles and main color (orange) yarns Cast on 60 sts, place sts marker and join in round. Knit first round

1 rnd. *k1MC, k1CC* repeat until end 2-3 rnds. Latvian braid 4-6 rnds. KMC until end 7 rnd. *k3MC, k1CC, k8MC, k1CC, k2MC* repeat until end 8 rnd. *k3MC, k1CC, k8MC, k1CC, k2MC*repeat until end 9 rnd. *k1MC, k1CC, k1MC, k2CC, k1MC, k4CC, k1MC, k2CC, k1MC, k1CC* repeat until end 10 rnd. *k1MC, k1CC, k2MC, k8CC, k2MC,k1CC* repeat until end 11 rnd. *k2MC, k2CC, k1MC, k6CC, k1MC,k2CC, k1MC* repeat until end 12 rnd. *k4MC, k8CC, k3MC* repeat until end 13 rnd. *k2MC, k2CC, k2MC, k4CC, k2MC,k2CC, k1MC* repeat until end 14 rnd. *k5MC, k1CC, k1MC, k2CC, k1MC,k1CC, k4MC* repeat until end 15 rnd. *k4MC, k1CC, k2MC, k2CC, k2MC,k1CC, k3MC* repeat until end 16 rnd. *k4MC, k1CC, k6MC, k1CC, k3MC*repeat until end 17-19 rnds. KMC until end 20 rnd. Repeat rnd 1. 21-22 rnds. Latvian Braid 23 rnd. KMC until end

Bind off

Weave the ends Enjoy!
