

THE FREE FRIDAY PATTERN

Yarn: Rita by Borgo de' Pazzi Firenze

Winds of Autumn is a neckwarmer worked bottom up in the round, with 10 ½ needles and Borgo de Pazzi Rita's yarn. Using larger needles let the knitted yarn have a destructured and loose finish & fit



MATERIAL:

- YARN: Borgo de' Pazzi Rita- 2 knitting balls 50 gr each (color 273/274)
- 10 ½ interchangeables needles 16 inches long cable
- Stitch marker
- Tapestry needle

INSTRUCTIONS:

With color 273 cast on 90 stitches. Close in the round, place marker.

- 1. Work two rounds in garther stitch
- 2. Work 3 rounds in stockinette stitch

Repeat instructions 1 and 2 for 4 inches.

- 3. Switch to color 274, and repeat instructions 1 and 2 once.
- 4. Switch to color 273 and work 2 inches repeating instructions 1 and 2.

Repeat instructions 3 and 4.

5. Cast off loosely all stitches, incorporate all the threads of yarn on wrong side of the work with the tapestry needle.
