

# Sarah Cardigan

Size: S/M

Would you like to size up or down? This can easily be done by making more or fewer rows and/or stitches. If you go a size up, you will need more balls of yarn.


### MATERIAL:

- YARN: Borgo de' Pazzi, Kid (80% kid mohair- 20% recycled polyammide, 50 gr/400 mt): 200 gr
- Knitting needles 8 and 12 mm
- Cable needle

**GAUGE**: 10x10cm on ndl 12 = 9 st wide and 11 st high.

## Stitches & abbreviations:

- Rib Stitch
- Stockinette stitch
- Cable stitch







### **INSTRUCTIONS**

Take the ends of the 5 balls together so that the 5 wires make one 'thick' one.

# **Back piece:**

Cast on 40st on ndl 8

Knit 6 rows in rib stitch ratio 1/1 (= K 1st – P 1st and repeat until the end of the ndl. Do the opposite in the next row.)

From now on it's in stockinette stitch (= K 1row - P 1row) with the cable in the middle

Row 7: increase 10st in this row to end up with 21K - 1P - 6K - 1P - 21K on your needle

This can be done by (for example) double knitting a loop, spread them a little left and right so they're not all next to each other.

Row 8: From here on use ndl 12 and K or P the way the st present themselves in order to make the stockinette stitch. = P21 - K1 - P6 - K1 - P21

Row 9: K21 - P1 - K6 - P1 - K21

Row 10: P21 - K1 - P6 - K1 - P21

Repeat rows 9 and 10 up to and including row 14

Row 15: K21 - P1 – take off 3st with the cableneedle and hang them on the front side of your piece (towards yourself), 'on hold' – K the 3 next st, put the 3 st from the cableneedle back on your regular needle and K those.(this makes the twist from the cablel)- P1 - K21

Repeat rows 9 and 10 up to and including row 22

Row 23: Repeat row 15

Repeat rows 9 and 10 up to and including row 30

Row 31: Repeat row 15

Repeat rows 9 and 10 up to and including row 38

Row 39: Repeat row 15

Repeat rows 9 and 10 up to and including row 46

Row 47: Repeat row 15

Repeat rows 9 and 10 up to and including row 54

Row 55: Repeat row 15

Repeat rows 9 and 10 up to and including row 62

Cast off





## Front pieces: Do this twice for a left and right piece

Cast on 20st on ndl 8

Knit 6 rows in rib stitch ratio 1/1

From now on it's in stockinette stitch

Row 7: K all st and increase 4st in this row and spread them over the ndl

Row 8: From here on use ndl 12, P all st

Row 9: K all st

Repeat rows 8 and 9 up to and including row 62

Cast off

## Sleeves: Do this twice for a left and right piece

Cast on 20st on ndl 8

Knit 6 rows in rib stitch ratio 1/1

Row 7: K all st R, increase 16st in this row and spread them over the ndl

From now on it's in stockinette stitch

Row 8: From here on use ndl 12, P all st

Row 9: K all st

Repeat rows 8 and 9 up to and including row 34

Row 35: increase 2 st. 1 st in the 2d and the other one in the second last st of the row

Repeat rows 8 and 9 up to and including row 44

#### Cast off

If you want you can block the pieces.

Sew the shoulder pieces together with the back piece, start from the outside and work your way inwards.

Put in the sleeves, close the sleeves and the side seams.

Tuck in all the loose threads.

Enjoy your cardigan!
