# Concrezioni stole

Veruska - happysloth.it

This stole is worked flat.

## SIZE: 170x33 cm/ 67x13 inches

## Level: easy

#### MATERIAL:

- YARN: Borgo de' Pazzi, Hemp 100 (100% hemp, 1.7 oz, 273 yds, 4 hanks col 77, 1 hank col 72)

- Hook: 3 mm

- Blunt tip needle, scissors

#### GAUGE:

28 stsx15 r, alternating 1 r of dc to one of sc, starting with a r of dc = 10x10 cm /4 inches Gauge is not essential for this project.

#### Special STITCHES:

#### US TERMINOLOGY USED

Front post bobble stitch: (sc, hdc, 2 dc) around the post of the next dc, inserting the hook front-to-back through your work.

#### STITCHES&ABBREVIATIONS

Front post bobble stitch (**fpb**); chain stitch (**ch**); double crochet (**dc**); repeat (**rep**); row (**r**); single crochet (**sc**); slip stitch (**sl st**); space (**sp**); stitch/es (**st/s**); yarn over (**yo**)

**Note**: instructions between asterisks must be repeated the number of times specified. Sometimes, our ch 3 are taller than our dc sts, in this case, your turning chain will be made of 2 ch sts.

When working in the same dc where you crocheted your fpb, be extra careful to work in the correct dc, because the top of the stitch will be partially hidden by the bobble st. If necessary, place a marker on the top of the dc before crocheting the fpb.





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#### INSTRUCTIONS:

Start: with purple yarn, ch 93.

1 r: dc in 4th ch from hook (ch-3 counts as 1 dc), and in all the other ch sts; turn work. (91 dc)

2 r: ch 1, sc in each dc; turn work. (91 sc)

3 r: ch-3 (counts as 1 dc), skip 1st sc, dc in each sc; turn work. (91 dc)

4 - 7: rep r 2-3.

8 r: rep r 2.

9 r: ch-3 (counts as 1 dc), skip 1st sc, dc in each sc; pull hook and, leaving a long loop, drop yarn, do not cut it. Do not turn your work.

10 r: Join yellow yarn to the 1st dc as follow: leaving a 15 cm/6 inches tail, with a loop on your hook, insert hook in 1st dc, yo, pull through, yarn over and complete your 1st sc; sc in each of the next 2 dc,  $f_{pb}$  in next dc, sc in same dc, sc in each of the next 2 dc,  $f_{rpb}$  in next dc, sc in each of the next 2 dc, sc in last dc as follow: insert hook in last dc, yo, pull through, drop the yellow yarn, insert hook in the purple loop and complete the st with the purple yarn. Cut yellow yarn, leaving a 15 cm/6 inches tail. Turn work. (91 sc, 15 fpb). This is the rights side of the work. All your fpb sts will be made on this side.

11 r: ch 1, sc in each sc (sc that are part of the fpb do not count as sc); turn work. (91 mb)

12-15 r: rep r 3-2.

16 r: rep r 9.

17-18 r: rep r 10-11.

19-24 r: rep r 3-2.

25 r: rep r 9.

26-27 r: rep r 10-11.

28-35 r: rep r 3-2.

36 r: rep r 9.

37-38 r: rep r 10-11.

39-48 r: rep r 3-2.







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Weave in yellow tails on one side of the stole only.
