



Antonia Hat

Size: S54-56 (M56-58) cm head circumference

GAUGE: with 4mm dpns in the Rd: 9x9cm = 24sts/30Rd

Materials:

BORGO DE' PAZZI Genio:

50g Colour Purple

50g Colour White

Dpns: 3mm, 3,5mm, 4mm

Darning needle

Stitches&Abbreviations:

Dpns: double-pointed-needles

st: stitch

Sts: stitches

k: knit

p: purl

R: Row

Rd: Round

RS: right side

WS: wrong side

P: purple

W: white

K2tog: knit two together

p3tog: purl three together

s2kp: slip 2 knitwise, k1, and pass slipped sts over

NOTES: I prefer to knit my hats a little bit smaller in the first place, because they loosen up with wearing and will adapt perfectly to the head after wearing a few times.)

Indications for size M are in brackets.



Instructions:

Cable cast on 104 (112)sts with 3,5mm dpns k1p1 rib for 10cm
Pick up 104 (112)sts with 3,0mm or 3,5mm dpns at the lower edge of the hat
Fold the brim in order to obtain two layers and work 3-needle bind off
Change to 4mm dpns and start patchwork

1. Patch

Only work with the 13(14) first sts of the Rd, leave the other sts on the other 3 needles. With right hand needle and P yarn, cast on 14(15) sts on first needle = 27(29) sts on first needle.

R1: RS knit with P
R2: WS p12(13), p3tog, p12(13)
R3: RS with W k11(12), s2kp, k11(12)
R4: WS k (garter st)
R5: RS with P k10(11), s2kp, k10(11)
R6: WS p
R7: RS with W k9(10), s2kp, k9(10)
R8: WS k (garter st)
R9: RS with P k8(9), s2kp, k8(9)
R10: WS p
R11: RS with W k7(8), s2kp, k7(8)
R12: WS k (garter st)
R13: RS with P k6(7), s2kp, k6(7)
R14: WS p
R15: RS with W k5(6), s2kp, k5(6)
R16: WS k (garter st)
R17: RS with P k4(5), s2kp, k4(5)
R18: WS p
R19: RS with W k3(4), s2kp, k3(4)
R20: WS k (garter st)
R21: RS with P k2(3), s2kp, k2(3)
R22: WS p
R23: RS with W k1(2), s2kp, k1(2)
Size S R24: WS k3tog = 1 st
Size M R24: WS p
R25: RS with P k1, s2kp, k1
R26: WS k3tog =1 st

2nd Patch

In order to move on to the next patch, with W (P) pick up 13(14) sts at the edge of the 1st patch in addition to the last left over live st of the first/last patch = 14(15) sts. Then knit the next 13(14) sts of the round = 27(29) sts. Work as for the 1st patch (for Size S: except that the colors are inverted which means you pick up sts and begin with W.) The white stripes are in garter st which means the white WS rows are knitted. This patch ends with P.

3rd Patch

In order to move on to the next patch, with P pick up 13(14) sts at the edge of the 2nd patch plus the last live st of the patch before = 14(15)sts and knit the next 13(14) sts of the round = 27(29)sts. Work as for the 1st patch. Note that the white stripes are always knitted on the WS to obtain a garter row.

4th patch: As 2nd
5th patch: As the 3rd
6th patch: As 2nd
7th patch: As 3rd

8th and last Patch

As 2nd BUT to join 8th and 1st patch work as follows:
Pick up 13(14) sts at the right edge of 1st patch and knit last st of every RS row together with the corresponding st on the edge of the 1st patch. Patches will be completely joined as soon as last row is reached. This way, the brim will close up. Now, 1st is left on the right hand dpn and the brim is completed.

Crown

After finishing the brim, you are left with 1 P st of the last patch. From there pick up 103(111) sts around the upper edge of finished patches with 4mm dpns and continue for the crown = 104(112) sts. TIP: Try to work joggles stripes trick to achieve neat changes of colors.

Rd 1: k with P
Rd 2: k with P
Rd 3: k with P
Rd 4: k with W
Rd 5: k with W
Size S: Begin with decreases or add some more rds until the desired height is attained:
Rd 6: with W *k11, k2tog* repeat 8 times from * = 96 sts
Rd 7: k with P
Rd 8: k with P
Rd 9: with P *k10, k2tog* repeat 8 times from * = 88 sts
Rd 10: k with W
Rd 11: k with W
Rd 12: with W *k9, k2tog* repeat 8 times from * = 80 sts
Rd 13: k with P
Rd 14: k with P
Rd 15: with W *k8, k2tog* repeat 8 times from * = 72 sts
Rd 16: k with W
Rd 17: with P *k7, k2tog* repeat 8 times from * = 64 sts
Rd 18: k with P
Rd 19: with W *k6, k2tog* repeat 8 times from * = 56 sts
Rd 20: k with W
Rd 21: with P *k5, k2tog* repeat 8 times from * = 48 sts
Rd 22: k with P
Rd 23: with W *k4, k2tog* repeat 8 times from * = 40 sts
Rd 24: k with P
Rd 25: with W *k3, k2tog* repeat 8 times from * = 32 sts
Rd 26: with W *k2, k2tog* repeat 8 Times from* = 24 sts
Rd 27: with W *k1, k2tog* repeat 8 times from * = 16 sts
Rd 28: with W *k2tog* repeat 8 times from * = 8 sts

Size M: Begin with decreases or add some more rds until the desired height is attained:

Rd6: with W *k12, k2tog* repeat 8 times from* = 104 sts
Rd7: k with P
Rd8: k with P
Rd 9: with P *k11, k2tog* repeat 8 times from * = 96 sts
Rd 10: k with W
Rd 11: k with W
Rd 12: with W *k10, k2tog* repeat 8 times from * = 88 sts
Rd 13: k with P
Rd 14: k with P
Rd 15: with W *k9, k2tog* repeat 8 times from * = 80 sts
Rd 16: k with W
Rd 17: k with P
Rd 18: with P *k8, k2tog* repeat 8 times from * = 72 sts
Rd 19: k with W
Rd 20: with W *k7, k2tog* repeat 8 times form * = 64 sts
Rd 21: k with P
Rd 22: with P *k6, k2tog* repeat 8 times from * = 56 sts
Rd 23: k with P
Rd 24: with P *k5, k2tog* repeat 8 times from * = 48 sts
Rd 25: k with P
Rd 26: with W *k4, k2tog* repeat 8 times from * = 40 sts
Rd 27: k with W
Rd 28: with W *k3, k2tog* repeat 8 times from * = 32 sts
Rd 29: with W *k2, k2tog* repeat 8 Times form* = 24 sts
Rd 30: with W *k1, k2tog* repeat 8 times from * = 16 sts
Rd 31: with W *k2tog* repeat 8 times from * = 8 sts

Knit 7-8 cm with the remaining 8 sts in white (TIP: work the i-cord method: place all sts on one dpn and work only with 2 dpns), *k2tog* repeat from * 4 times = 4 sts left, sew through the 4 remaining sts twice and pull end on the inside, sew in. Make a simple knot at the bottom of the i-cord

FINISHING

Sew in all ends. Block.

Genio

50% Wool - 30% Bamboo -20% Kid Mohair

50 gr - 150 mt
Suggested Needles: 4-4,5 mm
10x10 cm = 21 sts x 25 rows
