About 200x54 cm

## Level

Easy

## Yarn

Borgo de'Pazzi, Hahhan, 100 lyocell, 100 gr/330 m, 3 balls: colors 6, 7, 17.

## Hook

3,5 mm

Blunt tip needle, scissors

## Gauge

## Section 1

$10 \times 10 \mathrm{~cm}$
Chain 24
1 row: sc in 2nd ch from hook and in all ch sts. Turn work.
2 row: ch 2, *dc in next sc, ch 1, sk 1 sc*; rep from * to *, dc in second to last sc, dc in last sc. Turn work.
3 row: ch 3 (counts as 1 esc, ch 1), *esc in next ch-1 space, ch 1*; rep from * to *, esc in 2nd st of tc. Turn work.
4 row: ch 2 (counts as 1 dc), *dc in next ch-1 space, ch 1*; rep from * to *, dc in ch-3 space, dc in 2nd st of tc. Turn work.
Rep r 3 and 4, 7 more times, rep r 3, 1 time.

## Section 2

$10 \times 10 \mathrm{~cm}$
Chain 22+3
1 row: tr in 4th ch from hook, *ch 1, tr in next ch st*; rep from * to *, tr in last ch st.Turn work.
2 row: ch 1, sc in next tr, *ch 1, sc in next ch-1 space*; rep from * to *, ending with ch 1, sc in 3rd st of tc. Turn work.
3 row: ch 3, *ch 1, tr in next ch-1 space*; rep from * to *, tr in last sc.
Rep r 2 and 3, 3 more times.

## Construction notes

Un'estate al mare is a wrap worked in rows.
For each section, a different color and stitch pattern have been chosen.
The combination of stitches creates a slightly flaring wrap.

## Special stitches

Elongated single crochet: insert hook in next st, yarn over, pull up a loop, yarn over, draw it through 1 loop, yarn over, draw through both loops.

## Stitches, techniques and abbreviations

chain stitch (ch);double crochet (dc); treble crochet (tr); single crochet (sc); skip one stitch (sk); elongated single crochet (esc); slip stitch (sl st); stitch (st); repeat (rep); turning chain (tc). US English is used in this pattern.


## INSTRUCTIONS

## First section

Start: With dark green, ch 428.
1 r : sc in 2 nd ch from hook and in every ch st. Turn work.
2 r: ch 3 (count as dc, ch 1), *sk 1 sc, dc in next sc, ch 1*; rep from * to *, ending with dc in last sc. Turn work.
3 r: ch 2 (count as 1 esc), *esc in next ch-1 space, ch $1^{*}$; rep from * to *, ending with esc in ch-3 space, esc in 2nd st of tc. Turn work.
4 r: ch 3, *dc in next ch-1 space, ch 1*; rep from * to *, ending with dc in 2nd st of tc. Turn work.
Rep r 3 and 4, 5 more times.
Cut yarn.

## Second section

$1 r$ : with light green, ch 1, sc in same st, *ch 1, sc in next dc*; rep from * to * till end of row.
Turn work.
2 r: ch 3, *tr in next ch-1 space, ch 1*; rep from * to *, ending with tr in last ch-1 space, tr in last sc. Turn work.
3 r: ch 1, sc in same tr, *ch 1, sc in next ch-1 space*; rep from * to *, ending with ch 1, skip next tr, sc in 3rd st of tc. Turn work.
Rep r 2 and 3, 4 other times, rep $r 2$ once.
Cut yarn.

## Third section

1 r: with beige, ch 1, sc in same tr, sc in next tr, *ch 1, sc in next tr*; rep from * to *, ending with sc in 3rd st of tc. Turn work.

2 r: ch 7 (count as dc, ch 5), *sk 5 sts, dc in next ch-1 space, ch 2, sk 2 sts, sc in next sc, ch 2, sk 2 sts, dc in next ch-1 space, ch 5*; rep from * to *, ending with a dc in last sc.
Turn work.
3 r: ch 4 (count as 1 dc, ch 2), *sc in next ch-5 space, ch 2 , dc in next dc, ch 5 , dc in next dc, ch 2*; rep from * to *, (sc, ch 2) in ch-7 space, dc in 2nd of tc. Turn work.
4 r: ch 7, *dc in next dc, ch 2 , sc in next ch-5 space, ch 2 , dc in next dc, ch 5 , sk 5 sts*; rep from * to *, ending with dc in 2nd st of ch-4 space. Turn work.
Rep r 3 and 410 more times.
15 r: ch 1, sc in same dc, *(sc in next ch-5 space, ch 1) 3 times, sc in next ch-2 space, ch 1, sc in next sc, ch 1, sc in next ch-2 space, ch 1*; rep from * to *, ending with [(sc, ch 1) twice, $s c]$ in ch-7 space, sc in $2 n d$ st of ch-7 tc. Turn work.
Cut yarn.

## Fourth Section

$1 r$ : with light green, ch 3, tr in next sc, *ch 1, tr in next sc*; rep from * to *, ending with tr in last sc. Turn work.
2 r: rep 3 of the Second Section.
$3 r$ : rep $r 2$ of the Second Section.
Rep r 2 and 3, one more time, rep r 2 once.
Cut yarn.

## Fifth section

1 r: with dark green, ch 3 (count as dc, ch 1), *dc in next sc, ch 1*; rep from * to *, ending with dc in last sc. Turn work.
2 r: rep r 3 of First Section.
3 r: rep r 4 of First Section.
Rep r 2 and 3 once.
6 r: ch 1, sc in same dc, *sc in next ch-1 space, sc in next dc*; rep from * to *, ending with sc in $3 r d$ st of tc, sc in 2nd st of tc.

Cut yarn.

## Finishing

Weave in ends. Add fringes, using the picture as a guide.
Wash and block to measure.
