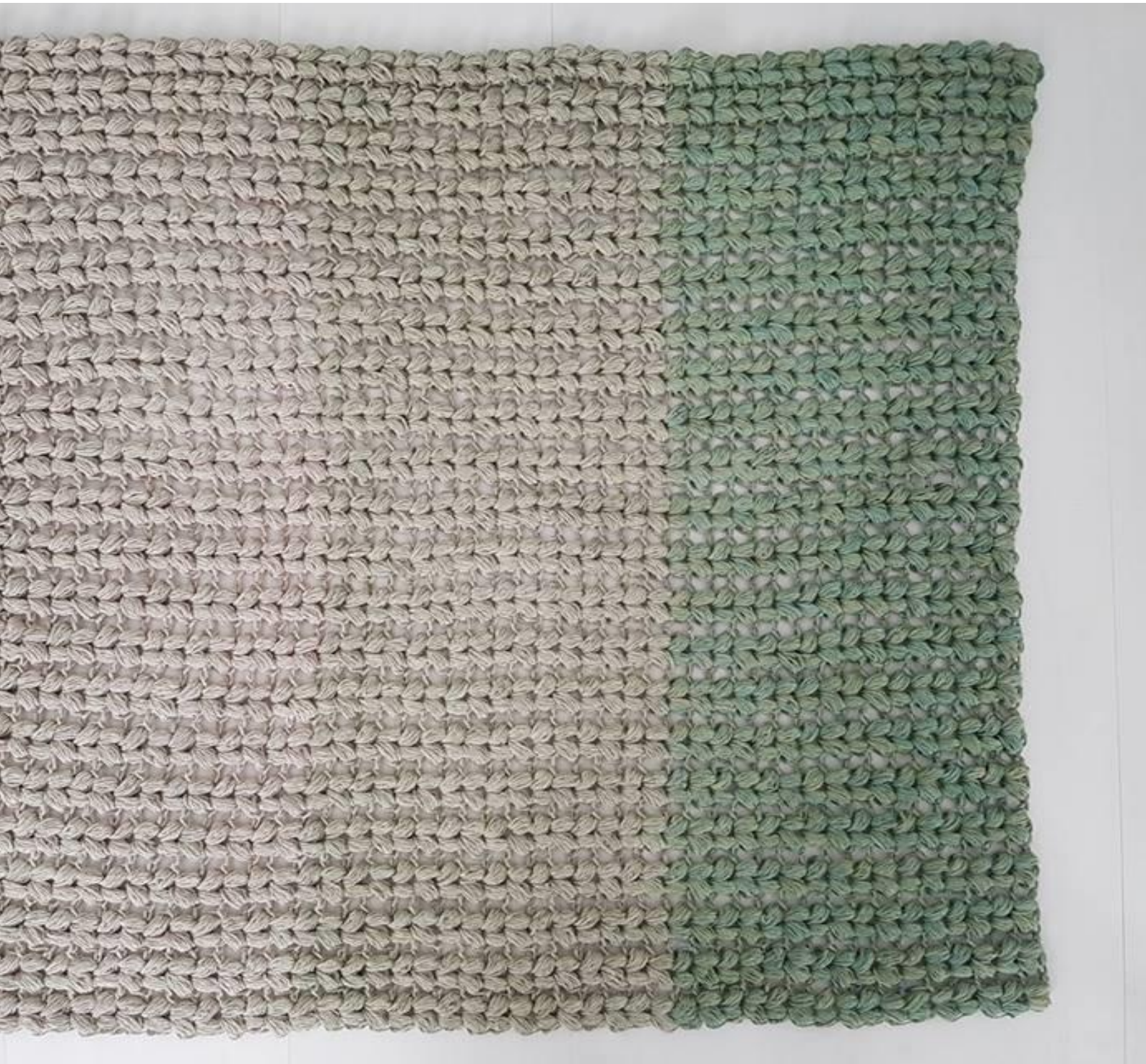


# Spring Leaves Rug

## Material

900 g Raw Linen (100% linnen)

3x 191

3x 192

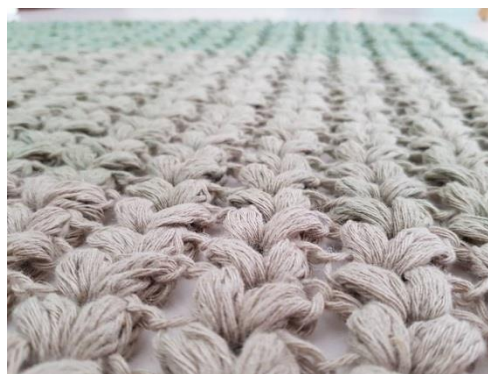
3x 193

Crochet hook 7 mm

Scissors

Tape-measure

Sewing needle



## Raw Linen

Raw Linen yarn is made from an environmentally friendly fiber. Thanks to a special treatment, the yarn retains its natural look. The raw material for Raw Linen comes from the lower part of the linen plant. The yarn feels a bit rougher and is perfect for crocheting home-deco projects or bags. The yarns has a jute/rope look.

## Method

The rug is crocheted with 3 different shades of color. The idea arose to show a light yet clear difference, with soft tones of beige and forest green. This pattern is a lovely basic pattern and easy to start with. You can also choose to crochet this rug in a singular or multiple color(s). Every color row exist of 16 rows, I have used 3 balls for 16 rows (16 rows = 25 cm height).

A V-Stitch can be explained as follows: 2 chainstitches, 7 unfinished double crochet (14 loops on the hook) close with a slipstitch and repeat once more. This is why the stitch is V-shaped.

## Used stitches

Chainstitch

Slipstitch

V-Stitch

## Measurements

Wide 76 cm

Length 76 cm

## Pattern

Start with chaining 85 chainstitches + 2. The 2 extra chainstitches are needed for the height.

**Row 1:** Start in the third chainstitch from the needle with a V-Stitch. Skip 3 chainstitches and crochet again a V-Stitch. Repeat till the end. So, V-Stitch, skip 3 chainstitches, V-Stitch.

**Row 2:** Turn your work. Crochet 2 chainstitches and crochet a V-Stitch in the hole of the previous row. Repeat till the end of the row. Tie after 16 rows the thread off and continue with a new color.
