



# **Green Bee**

Messenger / Laptop bag

Size after blocking: Width: about 41 cm Height: about 30 cm

#### Gauge:

10 cm = 12 stitches measured after blocking

Level: easy

Materials:

Yarn: Stout Uni by Borgo de'Pazzi col. 107 (100% wool- 200 g. +/- 300 m.): 400 g. (2 skeins).

Needles: 6 mm circular needles with 80 cm cable. Crochet: 6 mm crochet hook and Prym Smirne hook. Other material: Row counter, tapestry needle, 2 silver rings.

#### Stitches&Abbreviations:

K: knit.
P: purl.
Gs: Garter Stitch.
S1kw: slip 1 stitch knitwise, without working it.
S1pw: slip 1 purlwise, without working it.
HCS: Honey Comb Stitch.
K2tog: Knit 2 stitches together.
ssk: slip 1 stitch onto the right needle, slip the next one, slip them back to the left needle and knit them together through the back loop
HCS: Honey Comb stitch.

Row 1: \*k1, k1 inserting the needle into the stitch of the previous row\*, k1. Row 2 and all even rows: k. Row 3: k1, \*k1, k1 inserting the needle into the stitch of the previous row \*, k2. Keep going repeating Row 1 to Row 4. Helping video: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=37oQXJjBicM

#### INSTRUCTIONS

Using the Crochet Cast on cast on 51 stitches and work them as follows: Foundation Row: p1, k49, p1.

Row 1: s1kw, k49, s1kw. Row 2: p1, k49, p1. Repeat Row 1 to Row 2 twice.

Continue as follows: **Row 5**: s1kw, HCS49, k1. (Row 1 of HCS explanation).

**Row 6:** s1pw, k49, p1.

Row 7: s1kw, HCS49, k1. (Row 3 of HCS explanation).

Row 8: s1pw, k49, p1.

## Repeat Row 5 to Row 8 20 more times, then work as follows:

Row 85: s1kw, p49, k1.

Row 86: s1pw, k49, p1.

Row 87 to Row 174: repeat Row 5 to Row 8 22 times.

Row 175: k3, p45, k3.

Row 176: k3, k45, k3.

Row 177: k3, HCS45, k3. (Row 1 of HCS explanation).

Row 178: k.

Row 179: k3, HCS45, k3. (Row 3 of HCS explanation).

Row 180: k.

## Repeat Row 177 to Row 180 once again.

**Row 185**: k3, ssk, HCS (Row 1 of HCS explanation) until 5 stitches from the end of the row, k2tog, k3. **Row 187**: k3, HCS (Row 1 of HCS explanation) until 3 stitches from the end of the row, k3.

**Row 189**: k3, ssk, HCS (Row 3 of HCS explanation) until 5 stitches from the end of the row, k2tog, k3.

Row 191: k3, HCS (Row 3 of HCS explanation) until 3 stitches from the end of the row, k3.

Repeat Row 185 to Row 191 twice more.

**Row 209**: k3, ssk, HCS (Row 1 of HCS explanation) until 5 stitches from the end of the row, k2tog, k3.

## Repeat Row 209 6 more times.

Row 223: k3, ssk, k until 5 stitches from the end of the row, k2tog, k3.

Row 224: k.

Repeat Row 223 to Row 224 once again.

Bind off all stitches.

## Finishing:

Sew the lateral sides of the bag and place the rings as in the photo.

Prepare a 150 cm I-cord (see helping video about Rumenian I-Cord), pass it through the rings and sew the ends with invisible stitches.
