



Snowflake



This set wears toddler size, it fits children from 3 to 5 years old.

This pattern is written in US standard therms.

#### SIZE:

3-5 anni

#### MATERIAL:

- YARN: 350 gr LUNA BY Borgo dè Pazzi Firenze

- Crochet hook: 6,5 - 7mm

- Wool needle and scissor.

# STITCHES&ABBREVIATIONS:

CH: chain

SLST: slip stitch ST/sts: stitche/s SC: single crochet HDC: half double crochet DC: double crochet BS: bubble stitch

SK: skip

SHELLST:shell stitch

BLOSC: back loop only single crochet

#### GAUGE:

10 HDC worked in round for 8 rounds with 7mm hook make a10x10 cm square. You have to respect the gauge to have the same size set at the end of your work.











#### INSTRUCTIONS:

## PONCHO:

This poncho in worked in top down, when you finish the main part can edging the bottom and refill the neck part. No sewing is needed.

## CH2 at the rows start DO NOT COUNT as a HDC. DO NOT turn the work at the end of every round.

With 7mm crochet hook start with a CH51. Close in a ring with a SLST in the first CH.

RD1: CH2, work 1HDC in each CH all the round. (50 HDC)

Close with a SLST in the fist HDC.

RD2: CH2, \* 1 HDC in the next 4STS, 2 HDC in the next ST \* repeat from \* to \* all the round. Close with a SLST in the fist HDC.

RD3: CH2, \* 5 HDC in the next STS, 1 BS in the next ST \*

repeat from \* to \* all the round. Close with a SLST in the fist HDC.

RD4: CH2, \* 1 HDC in the next ST \* repeat from \* to \* all the round.

Close with a SLST in the fist HDC.

RD5: CH2, \* 1 HDC in the next 5 STS, 2 HDC in the next ST \* repeat from \* to\* all the round. Close ith a SLST in the fist HDC.

RD6: CH2, \* 6 HDC in the next STS, 1 BS in the next ST \* repeat from \* to \* all the round. Close with a SLST in the fist HDC.

RD7: CH2, \* 1 HDC in the next ST \* repeat from \* to \* all the round.

Close with a SLST in the fist HDC.

RD8: CH2, \* 1 HDC in the next 6 STS, 2 HDC in the next ST \* repeat from \* to \* all the round. Close with a SLST in the fist HDC.

RD9\_10: CH2, \* 1 HDC in the next ST \*repeat from \* to \* all the round.

Close with a SLST in the fist HDC.

RD11:CH2, \* 1 HDC in the next 7 STS, 2 HDC in the next ST \* repeat from \* to \* all the round. Close with a SLST in the fist HDC.

RD12: CH2, \*1 HDC in the next ST \* repeat from \* to \* all the round.

Close with a SLST in the fist HDC.

RD13: CH2, \* 1 HDC in the nexts 8 STS, 2 HDC in the next ST \* repeat from \* to \* all the round. Close with a SLST in the fist HDC.











RD14\_15: CH2,\* 1 HDC in the next ST \*repeat from \* to \* all the round.

Close with a SLST in the fist HDC.

RD16: CH2, \* 1 HDC in the next 9 STS, 2 HDC in the next ST \* repeat from \* to \* all the round. Close with a SLST in the fist HDC.

RD17 18: CH2, \* 1 HDC in the next ST \*repeat from \* to \* all the round.

Close with a SLST in the fist HDC.

RD19:CH2, \* 1 HDC in the next 10 STS, 2 HDC in the next ST \* repeat from \* to \* all the round. Close with a SLST in the fist HDC.

RD20:CH2, \* 1 HDC in the next ST \*repeat from \* to \* all the round.

Close with a SLST in the fist HDC.

**RD21**: CH2, \* 1 HDC in the next 11 STS, 2 HDC in the next ST \* repeat from \* to \* all the round. Close with a SLST in the fist HDC.

RD22: CH2, \* 12 HDC in the next STS, 1 BS in the next ST \* repeat from \* to \* all the round. Close with a SLST in the fist HDC.

RD23: CH2, \* 1 HDC in the next ST \* repeat from \* to \* all the round.

Close with a SLST in the fist HDC.

At this point you have to edging the border with a fancy shell stitch.

SHELLST: work in the same ST: 1HDC, 3DC, 1HDC.

RD24: CH1, \* SHELLST in the next ST, SC1 in the next ST \* repeat from \* to \* all the round. Close with a SLST in the fist CH1.

Now you have to refill the neck edge, switch the hook in 6,5mm and work in your foundation CH.

RD25: CH2, \* 3 HDC in the next STS, work 2 HDC closed together in the nexts STS (DECREASE 1) \* repeat from \* to \* all the round. Close with a SLST in the fist HDC. RD26\_29: CH2, \* 1 HDC in the next ST \* repeat from \* to \* all the round. Close with a SLST in the fist HDC.

Cut the yarn and hide the yarn tails.









## SLOUCHY HAT

This hat is worked before in flat, starting from the ribbing.

You have to crochet a rectangle 6x45 cm, then sew it in a ring. You obtain a sort of headband.

Add rows in HDC working in round at the top of your headband and you will obtain a cilinder.

Sew it on the top to close all the work. If you prefer you can add a cute pompom.

With 6.5mm crochet hook start with a CH7.

RD: SC in the second CH from the hook, work a SC in eac CH (6 SC), turn the work.

ROW2 to the end until 45cm of lenght: CH1, BLOSC in the next STS until the end of the row.

Sew the rectangle in a ring.

From now you must work in the round. DO NOT turn the work at the end of the rounds. Start to work at the side of your ring.
From now CH2 DO NOT count as a HDC

RD1:CH2, work 60 HDC evenly spaced all the round.

Close with a SLST in the fist HDC.

RD2: CH2, \* 5 HDC in the nexts STS, 1 BS in the next ST \* repeat from \* to \* all the round. Close with a SLST in the fist HDC.

RD3\_10: CH2, \* 1 HDC in the next ST \* repeat from \* to \* all the round.

Close with a SLST in the fist HDC.

RD11: CH2, \* 4 HDC in the next STS, work 2 HDC closed together in the next STS (DECREASE 1) \* repeat from \* to \* all the round. Close with a SLST in the fist HDC. RD12\_13: CH2, \* 1 HDC in the next ST \* repeat from \* to \* all the round. Close with a SLST in the fist HDC.

RD14:CH2, \* 3 HDC in the next STS, work 2 HDC closed together in the next STS (DECREASE 1) \* repeat from \* to \* all the round. Close with a SLST in the fist HDC. RD15: CH2, \* 2 HDC in the nextSTS, work 2 HDC closed together in the next STS (DECREASE 1) \* repeat from \* to \* all the round. Close with a SLST in the fist HDC. RD16: CH2, \* 1 HDC in the next STS, work 2 HDC closed together in the next STS (DECREASE 1) \* repeat from \* to \* all the round. Close with a SLST in the fist HDC.

Cut the yarn with a long tail and use it to sew the top of your hat. Hide the yarn tails.
