Dimensions

cm 178 x 18

Skill Level

Easy

MATERIALS

Yarn

Borgo de'Pazzi Firenze®, Stout, 200 gr, 100% wool, 1 skein

Knitting needles:

 $7 \, \mathrm{mm}$

Gauge

10x10 cm = 12 sts x 14 rows



Stitches

K (knit)

P (purl)

Spine Stitch: C2B/C2F: 4 sts at the beginning and at the end of each row.

C2B: Knit second st thorugh back loop, keeping it on the needle; knit first st. through back loop and slip both stitches at the same time.

C2F: Knit in the same way, but on front loop.

Cr3LP: Cross 3 sts on the left purlwise (put 2 sts on hold to front, P1, K 2 sts on hold) Cr3RP: Cross 3 sts on the right purlwise (put 1 st on hold to back, K2, P 1 st on hold) Cr4LK: Cross 4 sts on the left knitwise (put 2 st on hold to front, K2, K2 sts on hold)



Execution

Note: Work stitches on even needles as they appear (knit the knits and purl the purls)
First and last 4 sts on each row are worked in Spine Stitch (SS): C2B/C2F on right side (odd needles), Purl on wrong side (even needles):

R23: SS - K2 - P8 - Cr4LK - P8 - K2 - SS

Repeat R5-R23 10 times

Third to last row: K (wrong side of work)

Second to last row: P

Last Row: P

Cast off (right side of work)

Wash the sarf with delicate detergent in lukewarm water. Put is in a bath towl and ring out. Dry flat. Wave in ends.
