





"BIO" Hat by Chiara Chiavacci



Materials:

-3 Bio yarn balls in different colors (tot 150 gr) -S/4 double pointed needles or 2 circular needles in different colors or materials: 4,5 and 5,00 mm -Row counter

Gauge 1

16 st x 20 rows = 10 cm (stockinette st -5 mmneedles)

Hat size: 56 – 58 mm Decrase/increase 4 st for every size (smaller/larger).

Stitches:

K (knit) P (purl) 2x2 Rib (K2-P2) Inc: increase - knit from front and back loop (1 stitch increase) Dec: decrease – K2Tog = knit 2 sts together

Notes:

When changing yarn color, leave all yarns attached; Put the yarn balls "on hold" inside the work, so that the yarn "crossing" appears on the inner side of the hat.

In order to avoid lack of tension, hold yarn slightly tighter on first stitches of every needle.



Bio Hat

Using 4,5 mm needles, cast on 84 stitches. Row 1-14: Rib st 2x2 (K2-P2) Change to 5 mm needles Row 15 - Increases: K2 - K1 F/B Loop (end with K3) A - Change to color 2 Row 16 - 18: K B - Change to color 1 Row 19-20: K C - Change to color 3 Row 21-22: K A- Change to color 2 Row 23 - 25: K B - Change to color 1 (leave 2nd color yarn attached) Row 26-27: K C - Change to color 3 Row 28-29: K A- Change to color 2 Row 30 - 32: K B - Change to color 1 Row 33-34: K C - Change to color 3 Row 35-36: K A- Change to color 2 Row 37-40: K B - Change to color 1 Row 41-42: K C - Change to color 3 Row 43-44: K A- Change to color 2 Row 45 - 47: K Change to color 1 – Decrasing row Row 48: K3 – K2Tog Row 49-50: K Row 51: K1 – K2Tog (end with K2) Row 52-53: K Row 54: K1 - K2Tog Row 55: K Row 56-57: K2Tog (10 st left)

Run a tapestry needle through the 10 live stitches and pull tight, weave in ends

Secure all inner tales.
