



Cherry Rose

Level: intermediate

Yarn: Alpaca Superfine by Borgo de'Pazzi, 100% Luxurious Alpaca superfine, 50 gr +/- 135 m: 300 gr.

Needles: 4 mm with 80 cm cable.

Others: auxiliary cable needle to put some stitches on hold, revolution counter, tapestry needle

Final Size of the Shawl once blocked:

Height: about 30 cm.

Width: about 215 cm

Gauge: 10cm = 24 stitch worked with prime rose stitch.

Stitches&Abbreviations:

K: Knit

KBL: Knit through the back loop

PBL: Purl through the back loop

K2tog: Knit two stitches together

P: Purl

EP4: Purl 4 stitches yarning over twice

SSK: Slip, slip, Knit.

SSP: Slip, Slip, Purl

W&T: Wrap and Turn: see special techniques

P4Wrap: 4 purl stitches wrapped. (See Special Techniques).

Y/O: Yarn Over

Prime Rose: worked on 4 stitches: slip the 4 purl stitches dropping the Y/O onto the right needle: put them back onto the left needle and work them together 4 times (KBL1, PBL1, KBL1, PBL1)

Special Techniques:

w&t = wrap & turn: On the right side of the work: work until you reach the stitch which needs to be wrapped, put the yarn on the front side of the work, slip 1 stitch onto the right needle as you were purling it, put the yarn on the back side of the work, slip back the stitch onto the left needle and turn your work; go on working in the opposite direction.

On the wrong side of the work, work until you reach the stitch which needs to be wrapped, put the yarn on the back side of the work, slip 1 stitch onto the right needle as you were purling it, put the yarn on the front side of the work, slip back the stitch onto the left needle and turn your work; go on working in the opposite direction.

How to work wrapped stitches:

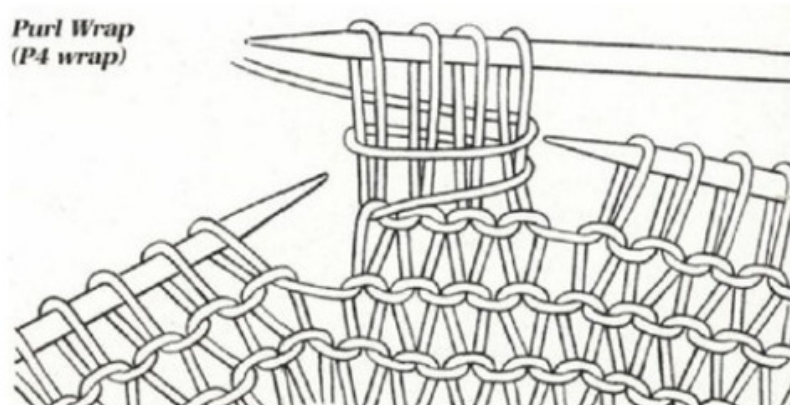
On the right side of the work: lift the wrapping yarn from the front side of the work, put it onto the left needle and knit the yarn and the stitch together.

On the wrong side of the work: lift the wrapping yarn from the back side of the work and put it onto the left needle and purl the yarn and the stitch together.

P4Wrap: Purl 4 stitches and put them onto an auxiliary cable needle as indicated in the drawing below. Wrap them 4 times with the yarn, slip them onto the right needle and continue working on the other stitches as indicated in the instructions.



NOTICE

The right side of the work, when you work the shells in the first part, is on even rows. Starting from row 19 (short rows) the right side of the work is on odd rows.

INSTRUCTIONS

Cast on 530 stitches and work the shells.

Row 1: K.

Row 2: P.

Row 3: K.

Row 4: K2, (Y/O, K21) till 3 stitches from the end, K3.

Row 5: K1, P2, *(P1, K3) 5 times, P2*, repeat from * to * till 2 stitches from the end, P1, K1.

Row 6: K2, * K1, Y/O, K1, (P3K1) 5 times, Y/O*, repeat from * to * till 3 stitches from the end, K3.

Row 7: K1, P2, *P2, (K3, P1) 5 times, P2 *, repeat from * to * till 2 stitches from the end, P1, K1.

Row 8: K2, *(K1, Y/O) 2 times, (ssk, P2) 5 times, (K1, Y/O) 2 times*, repeat from * to * till 3 stitches from the end, K3.

Row 9: K1, P2, *P4, (K2, P1) 5 times, P4*, repeat from * to * till 2 stitches from the end, P1, K1.

Row 10: K2, *(K1, Y/O) 4 times, (ssk, P1) 5 times, (K1, Y/O) 4 times*, repeat from * to * till 3 stitches from the end, K3.

Row 11: K1, P2, *P8, (K1, P1) 5 times, P8*, repeat from * to * till 2 stitches from the end of the row, P1, K1.

Row 12: K2, *K8, (ssk) 5 times, K8*, repeat from * to * till 3 stitches from the end, K3.

Row 13: K1, P2, *P8, P4wrap, P9*, repeat from * to * till 2 stitches from the end, P1, K1.

Row 14: K.

Repeat Row 1 to Row 13 once again and then continue as follows:

Row 14: K14, K2tog, *K19, K2tog* till 31 stitches from the end, K31.

Row 15: K506 .

Row 16: P506.

Row 17: K506 .

Row 18: K506 . Cut the yarn.

Now we start with short rows on the right side of the work.

Row 19: slip 233 stitches onto the right needle, K40, w&t.

Row 20: P8, EP4, P16, EP4, P8 + P12, w&t.

Row 21: K20, Prime Rose, K16, Prime Rose, K8 + K12, w&t.

Row 22: P64 + P12, w&t.

Row 23: K76 + K12, w&t.



Row 24: P2, EP4, P16, EP4, P16, EP4, P16, EP4, P16, EP4, P2 + P12, w&t.
 Row 25: K14, Prime Rose, K16, Prime Rose, K16, Prime Rose, K16, Prime Rose, K16, Prime Rose, K2 + K12, w&t.
 Row 26: P112 + P12, w&t.
 Row 27: K124 + K12, w&t.
 Row 28: (P16, EP4) 6 times, P16 + P10, w&t.
 Row 29: K26, (Prime Rose, K16) 6 times + K10, w&t.
 Row 30: P156 + P10, w&t.
 Row 31: K166 + K10, w&t.
 Row 32: K6, EP4, (P16, EP4) 8 times, P6 + P10, w&t.
 Row 33: (K16, Prime Rose) 9 times, K6 + K10, w&t.
 Row 34: P196 + P10, w&t.
 Row 35: K206 + K10, w&t.
 Row 36: (P16, EP4) 10 times, P16 + P8, w&t.
 Row 37: K24, (Prime Rose, K16) 10 times + K8, w&t.
 Row 38: P232 + P8, w&t.
 Row 39: K240 + K8, w&t.
 Row 40: P2, (EP4, P16) 12 times, EP4, P2 + P8, w&t.
 Row 41: K10, (Prime Rose, K16) 12 times, Prime Rose, K2 + K8, w&t.
 Row 42: P264 + P8, w&t.
 Row 43: K272 + K8, w&t.
 Row 44: K8, (EP4, P16) 13 times, EP4, P8 + P8, w&t.
 Row 45: (K16, Prime Rose) 14 times, K8 + K8, w&t.
 Row 46: P296 + P8, w&t.
 Row 47: K304 + K8, w&t.
 Row 48: P14, (EP4, P16) 14 times, EP4, P14 + P8, w&t.
 Row 49: K22, (Prime Rose, K16) 14 times, Prime Rose, K14 + K8, w&t.
 Row 50: P328 + P8, w&t.
 Row 51: K336 + K8, w&t.
 Row 52: (EP4, P16) 18 times, EP4 + P8, w&t.
 Row 53: K8, (Prime Rose, K16) 17 times, Prime Rose + K8, w&t.
 Row 54: P360 + P8, w&t.
 Row 55: K368 + K8, w&t.
 Row 56: P6, (EP4, P16) 18 times, EP4, P6 + P6, w&t.
 Row 57: K12, (Prime Rose, K16) 18 times, Prime Rose, K6 + K6, w&t.
 Row 58: P388 + P6, w&t.
 Row 59: K394 + K6, w&t.
 Row 60: P8, (EP4, P16) 19 times, EP4, P8 + P6, w&t.
 Row 61: K14, (Prime Rose, K16) 19 times, Prime Rose, K8 + K6, w&t.
 Row 62: P412 + P4, w&t.
 Row 63: K416 + K4, w&t.
