



Set Onde

Cowl & Beanie

Cowls size:

Circumference about 130 cm, height about 20 cm.

Swatch:

10 stitches worked with the Tunisian Wave Stitch and hook nr. 12 = 10 cm

11 stitches worked with the Tunisian Wave Stitch and hook nr 10 = 10 cm

Material:

Yarn: Bio - Borgo de' Pazzi Firenze®, 100% natural wool

Scarf: 150 gr (3 balls), in 2 different colors (color 1: 2 balls - color 2: 1 ball).

Beanie: 100 gr (2 balls) in 2 different colors (color 1 - color 2).

Double Tunisian Hook nr .12 for the cowl

Double Tunisian hook nr. 10 for the beanie

1 lock stitch marker

Stitches&abbreviations:

Foundation row (round):

Casting on and forward row: make a chain as long as you need it. Insert the hook into the back bump of the first chain starting from the hook tip and take a loop. Repeat this pass until you have on the hook all necessary loops.

Back row: yarn over and pull it through 1 loop, *yarn over and pull it through 2 loops* repeat from * to * until you have only one loop on your hook.

Tunisian Simple Stitch:

Forward Row: Insert the hook into the next vertical front bar and pull up a loop and repeat this pass for the whole length of your work.

Back row: yarn over and pull it through 1 loop, *yarn over and pull it through 2 loops* repeat from * to * until you have only one loop on your hook.

2 rows (forward and back) are considered a complete row

Go on repeating this forward and back rows.

Tunisian Reverse Stitch:

Forward Row: Insert the hook into the next vertical back bar and pull up a loop and repeat this pass for the whole length of your work.

Back row: yarn over and pull it through 1 loop, *yarn over and pull it through 2 loops* repeat from * to * until you have only one loop on your hook.

2 rows (forward and back) are considered a complete row

Go on repeating this forward and back rows.

Tunisian Double Crochet:

Forward row: chain 1, yarn over and insert the hook into the next vertical bar, yarn over and pull it through 2 loops. Repeat this pass for the whole length of your work.

Back row: yarn over and pull it through 1 loop, *yarn over and pull it through 2 loops* repeat from * to * until you have only one loop on your hook.

2 rows (forward and back) are considered a complete row

Tunisian Knit Stitch:

Forward row: Insert the hook between the front and the back bar of the next stitch, yarn over and pull up a loop. Repeat this pass for the whole length of your work. .

Back row: yarn over and pull it through 1 loop, *yarn over and pull it through 2 loops* repeat from * to * until you have only one loop on your hook.

2 rows (forward and back) are considered a complete row

Tunisian Wave Stitch in the round:

Chain a multiple of 12 + 6

1st Forward round: *6 Tunisian Simple Stitches, 6 Tunisian Double Crochets*, repeat from *to * till 6 stitches before the stitch marker, 6 Tunisian Simple Stitches: work all stitches inserting the hook in the next vertical back bar.

Back round: Yarn over and pull it through 2 loops .

2nd Forward round: *6 Tunisian Double Crochet, 6 Tunisian Simple Stitches *, repeat from *to * till 6 stitches before the stitch marker , 6 Tunisian Double Crochets.

Back round: Yarn over and pull it through 2 loops

Go on repeating the complete 1st and 2nd round.

Tunisian Rib Stitch:

Forward Row: *1 Tunisian Knit Stitch, 1 Tunisian Reverse Stitch*, repeat this sequence for the whole length of your work.

Back row: yarn over and pull it through 1 loop, *yarn over and pull it through 2 loops* repeat from * to * until you have only one loop on your hook.

2 rows (forward and back) are considered a complete row

Go on repeating this complete row

Note:

Working in the round a complete round is meant 1 Forward and 1 Back Pass.

Cowl:

With color 1 chain loosely 126. Pay attention not to twist the chains. Close the chain in the round and work the foundation round, using color 2 for the back pass
Place a stitch marker at the beginning of the round and work a complete round in Tunisian Reverse Stitch, then go on working as follows: work the first complete round of Tunisian Wave Stitch inserting the hook in the back bar. Work the complete second round of Tunisian Wave Stitch and then work 8 more complete rounds alternating Round 1 and Round 2 of the Tunisian Wave Stitch.
Once finished work 1 complete round of Tunisian Reverse Stitch, binding off all stitches in the next Forward row.
Weave in, wet and block it. Wear it!

Beanie:

With color 1 chain loosely 54. Pay attention not to twist the chains. Close the chain in the round and work the foundation round, using color 2 for the back pass
Insert a stitch marker at the beginning of the round. Work 5 complete rounds in Tunisian Reverse Stitch and then go on working as follows: work the first complete round of Tunisian Wave Stitch inserting the hook in the back bar, work the complete second round of the Tunisian Wave Stitch, then repeat 4 times round the complete round 1 and round 2 of the Tunisian Wave Stitch. Repeat once again the complete round 1 of Tunisian Wave Stitch.

Now we begin decreasing always inserting the hook into the back bar:

1st Forward Round: *2 Tunisian Reverse Stitches, insert the hook in the next two back bars together pulling up a loop, 2 Tunisian Reverse Stitches, 2 Tunisian Double Crochets, Insert the hook in the next two back bars together and work out a Tunisian Double Crochet, 2 Tunisian Double Crochets taken in the back bars 2 *: repeat from * to * for the whole round ending with 2 Tunisian Reverse Stitches

All Back Rounds are worked yarning over and pulling the yarn through two loops.

2nd Forward Round: * 5 Tunisian Double Stitches inserting the hook into the back bar, 5 Tunisian Reverse Stitches*: repeat from * to * the whole round ending with 5 Tunisian Double Stitches inserting the hook into the back bar.

3rd Forward Round: * insert the hook into the next 2 back bars together and pull up a loop, 1 Tunisian Reverse Stitch, insert the hook into the next 2 back bars together and pull up a loop, Insert the hook in the next 2 back bars together and work a Tunisian Double Crochet, 1 Tunisian Double Crochet inserting the hook into the back bar, Insert the hook in the next 2 back bars together and work a Tunisian Double Crochet*: repeat from * to * for the whole round ending as follows: * insert the hook into the next 2 back bars together and pull up a loop, 1 Tunisian Reverse Stitch, insert the hook into the next 2 back bars together and pull up a loop.

Finishing:

Cut the yarns and weave them in the remaining stitches. Close firmly and fix the yarn in the back of the work. Weave the ends, wet and block it.

Alternative for the beanie edging:

Chain 54 loosely with color 1 and close the chain in the round taking care that the chains are not twisted. Work the foundation row using color 2 for the back pass. Insert a stitch marker and work 5 complete rounds Tunisian Rib Stitch, then go on working the Tunisian Wave Stitch.
