



Brilliant Capelet



Size: M/L

Gauge:

10 cm = 18 stitches worked in stockinette stitch (1 row garter stitch, 1 row purl stitch) with 5 mm needles.

Level: easy

Materials:

Yarn: Pello by Borgo de'Pazzi, (30% Poliamyde, 25% Mohair, 20% Wool, 20% Acrylic, 5% Metallic Fiber - 50 g +/- 135 m): 350 g (250 g Color 1 and 100 g Color 2).

5mm.circular needles with 60/80 cm cable.

5mm circular needles (short tips) and 40 cm cable.

Other materials: 5 stitch markers, round counter, tapestry needle.

Stitches&Abbreviations:

K: knit.

P: purl

M1R: with the left needle pick up the bar between the 2 stitches from the back, then knit 1 stitch.

M1L: with the left needle pick up the bar between the 2 stitches from the front, then knit through the back of the loop.

M: Stitch Marker

PM: Place Stitch Marker.

SM: Slip Stitch Marker.

BM: Stitch marker showing the beginning of a round.

PBM: Place a stitch marker showing the beginning of a round.

SBM: Slip the a stitch marker showing the beginning of the round

W&T: wrap and turn (see special techniques)

Special techniques:

Wrap & turn

On the right side of the work: work until the stitch which has to be wrapped and turned. Move the yarn on the front side of the work, slip one stitch on the right needle as to purl it, move again the yarn on the back of the work, slip back the wrapped stitch to the left needle and turn your work. Go on working in the opposite direction. On the wrong side of the work: work until the stitch which has to be wrapped and turned. Move the yarn on the back of the work, slip one stitch on the right needle as to purl it, move again the stitch on the front of the work, slip back the wrapped stitch to the left needle and turn your work. Go on working in the opposite direction. How to work wrapped stitches: On the right side of the work: lift the wrapping yarn from the front side of the work, put it on the left needle, and the stitch together. On the wrong side of the work: lift the wrapping yarn from the back of the work and put it on the left needle, purl the yarn and the stitch together. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=G4GxFvi4KD0



INSTRUCTIONS

The first part, till the end of the V neckline will be worked in forward and return rows. With 5mm short tips and 40 cm cable cast on 104 stitches and close in the round.

Row 1: PM, k1, k10, PM, k1, k40, PM, k1, k10, PM, k1, k2, turn your work. 38 stitches remain unworked. They will be reworked (2) at the end of every further row. Row 2: p68, turn your work. Row 3: k2, M1R, SM, k1, M1L, k10, M1R, SM, k1, M1L, k40, M1R, SM, k1, M1L, k10, M1R, SM, k1, M1L, k4, turn your work. Row 4: p80, turn your work. Row 5: k82, turn your work. Row 6: p84, turn your work. Row 7: k7, M1R, SM, k1, M1L, k12, M1R, SM, k1, M1L, k42, M1R, SM, k1, M1L, k12, M1R, SM, k1, M1L, k9, turn your work. Row 8: p96, turn your work. Row 9: k98, turn your work. Row 10: p100, turn your work. Row 11: k12, M1R, SM, k1, M1L, k14, M1R, SM, k1, M1L, k44, M1R, SM, k1, M1L, k14, M1R, SM, k1, M1L, k14, turn your work. Row 12: p112, turn your work. Row 13: k114, turn your work. Row 14: p116, turn your work. Row 15: k17, M1R, SM, k1, M1L, k16, M1R, SM, k1, M1L, k46, M1R, SM, k1, M1L, k16, M1R, SM, k1, M1L, k19, turn vour work. Row 16: p128, turn your work. Row 17: k130, turn your work. Row 18: p132, turn your work. Row 19 : k22, M1R, SM, k1, M1L, k18, M1R, SM, k1, M1L, k48, M1R, SM, k1, M1L, k18, M1R, SM, k1, M1L, k24, turn your work. Row 20: p144, turn your work. From now on continue to work in the round. PBM. Round 1: k till BM. Round 2: k till BM. Round 3: k till M, M1R, SM, k1, M1L, k till next M, M1R, SM, k1, M1L, k till next M, M1R, SM, k1, M1L, k till next M, M1R, SM, k1, M1L, k till BM. Round 4, 5 and 6: k till BM. Continue repeating Round3 to Round6 22 times (90 total rounds). Round 91: k till M (47), RM, k1, put on hold next 64 stitches, cast on 4 additional stitches, RM, k1, k till next M (94), RM, k1, put on hold next 64 stitches cast on 4 additional stitches, RM, k1, k till BM (47). Round 92: k till BM. Now we start to work in short rows on the 200 stitches of the front and back side. **Row 1:** k till 5 stitches before the BM, w&t. **Row 2:** p till 5 stitches before the BM, w&t. Row 3: k till 15 stitches before the BM, w&t. Row 4: p till 15 stitches before the BM, w&t. Row 5: k till 25 stitches before the BM, w&t. Row 6: p till 25 stitches before the BM, w&t. Row 7: k till 35 stitches before the BM, w&t. Row 8: p till 35 stitches before the BM, w&t. **Row 9**: k till 50 stitches before the BM, w&t. Row 10: p till 50 stitches before the BM, w&t. Row 11: k till 65 stitches before the BM, w&t.



Row 12: p till 65 stitches before the BM, w&t. Row 13: k till 85 stitches before the BM, w&t. Row 14: p till 85 stitches before the BM, w&t. Row 15: k till BM, RBM, k50, PBM. Now we start again to work in round. Round 93: with Color 2, k till BM. Round 94, 95, 96: with Color 2, p till BM. Round 97, 98, 99: with Color 1, k till BM. Round 100: with Color 2, k till BM. Round 101, 102, 103: with Color 2, p till BM. Round 104, 105, 106: with Color 1, k till BM. Round 107: with Color 2, k till BM. Round 108, 109, 110: with Color 2, p till BM. Round 111, 112, 113: with Color 1, k till BM. Round 114: with Color 2, k till BM. Round 115, 116, 117: with Color 2, p till BM. Bind off all stitches purlwise.

Sleeves border:

Rework 2 of the 4 additional stitches you previously casted on for the underarm, the 64 stitches you previously put on hold and the 2 remaining stitches of the underarm: PBM and work the border as done for the front and back part working Round 93 to Round 117. Bind off all stitches purlwise.

Neckline:

Rework 104 stitches from the V neckline starting from the left shoulder. Turn your work, so that the RS will be inside and work as follows:

Round 1: with Color 2, k till BM.
Round 2, 3, 4: with Color 2, p till BM.
Round 5, 6, 7: with Color 1, k till BM.
Repeat Round 1 to Round 7 five times.
Round 36, 37, 38: with Color 2, p till BM.
Bind off all stitches purlwise.

Finishing: Weave in the ends, wet and block it. Wear it.
